Main responsibilities:

To provide technical and operational expertise within the supervision of the activities of our conventional shipping lines' vessels routing between Northern Europe and West Africa including:

In the office:

- Preparing (pre-)stowage plans and relevant lifting arrangements, lashing plan manuals, method statements, risk assessments, etc.
- Providing guidance on cargo hold preparation and long-term maintenance
- Discussing stowage or cargo related topics with masters and owners
- Providing technical information about vessels and advising on cargo handling restrictions
- Being in close contact with the commercial team, analyzing the technical and operational constraints related to cargo booking (estimation of the commercial potential of the fleet)
- Daily monitoring of the vessels port operations in Europe and West Africa
- Assisting in cases of claims handling

Out of office:

- Physical supervision of stowage and securing of cargo
- Coordination of vessels' working program in accordance with BOCS operations department, port agents and stevedores
- Supervision of stevedoring work and special order loading/unloading operations
- Permanent inventory of handling and lashing materials
- Pre-inspection special cargo site
- Acting as company representative
- Interfacing between the owners, stevedores and ships

Core skills:

- Excellent knowledge of maritime Legal bases, especially IMO, SOLAS, IMDG rules as well as analysis of the results of the seaworthiness criteria
- Knowledge of ship construction structural strength trim stability
- Knowledge experience with stowage, lashing and other requirements for the carriage of conventional cargo/breakbulk/projects/heavy lifts
- Excellent communication skills oral written and interpersonal
- Fluent in English and French written and spoken (knowledge of German is considered an asset)
- Ability to effectively interact with ships' Masters, crew and other BOCS supercargoes
- Highly organized and strong attention to detail
- Proven problem solving skills and able to work under pressure
- Ability to make decisions and work independently
